

Park Playscape & Neighborhood Association Signage

In partnership with Counselor Renee Grout, we have received confirmation that our park play area will be replaced with new updated equipment.


Through this partnership, we have also received confirmation that our neighborhood association signs (at the corners near the park and the water tank) will be replaced. We were able to select an attractive, modern metal cut-out design that will elevate the look of our neighborhood entry points.

There are no estimated timelines for completion of either of these projects available to us at this time.

Park Area Traffic Control

The traffic control survey that we requested in November 2021 was completed July 2024 and determined that the street segment of Monte Verde next to the park qualifies for a traffic calming project. It has been placed on the city's list. We do not know (and cannot request) what traffic control measures will be implemented, nor do we know when the project will rise to the top of the priority list for funding.
