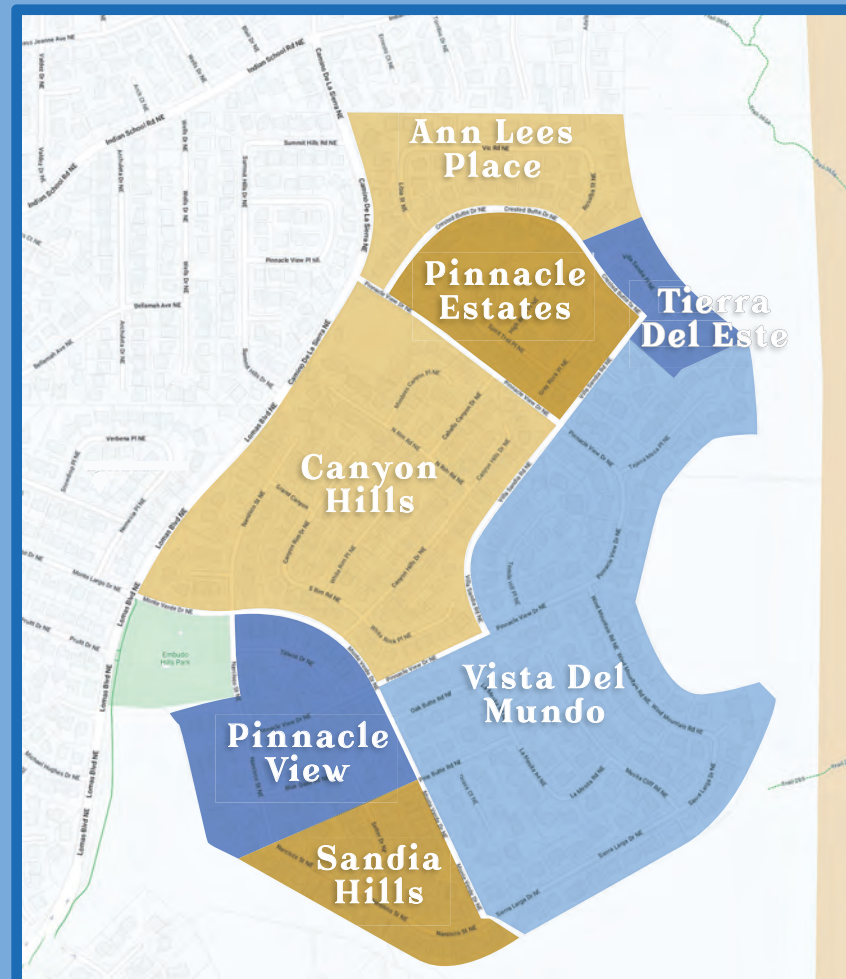

Home Water Pressure Awareness

While our Vista Del Mundo Neighborhoods are blessed to be located near the water tank located at Lomas and Pinnacle View Dr that supplies our homes and fire hydrants, we may be the unknowing recipients of high water pressure. The closer in proximity to the water tank, the more likely your home may be affected, and gravity can play a role as well. Newer homes are now built with PEX (cross-linked polyethylene) which can withstand higher water pressures, but many of our homes were built in the 1990s using traditional copper pipe.

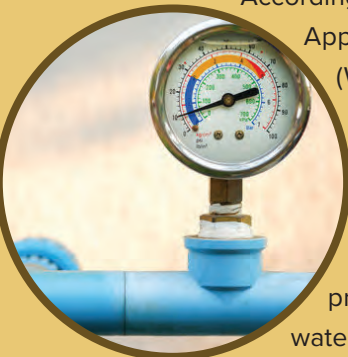
According to the EPA WaterSense Approved Certification Method (WACM), our water pressure should not exceed 80 PSI, while 40- 60 PSI is considered ideal. See QR Code below.

Why does it matter? High water pressure can lead to leaking water pipes or a leaking main water valve to the sprinkler system or home water supply, resulting in costly repairs.

If you are concerned about high water pressure, you can contact the ABCWUA (Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority) to request a technician test your water pressure to determine if it is in the acceptable range. Alternatively, you can buy a faucet water pressure gauge at most hardware stores to test your homes water pressure.

Solutions can include pressure reducing valves or water pressure regulators installed near your water meter at your expense.

Your VDMNA Board has worked hard on some projects that will benefit our neighborhood. Here is a status update of those efforts.



Park Area Traffic Control - 2026 Update

We remain concerned about the dangers posed to pedestrians by speeding near the Embudo Hills Park – specifically on Monte Verde Dr, between Lomas and Narcisco. With Councilor Renee Grout’s support, we propose 1 or more speed bumps in this short stretch of road. (see map ★)

Why not a stop sign? CABQ Traffic Engineering Division previously completed an analysis for a four way stop control at the intersection of Monte Verde and Narcisco – unfortunately, it did not meet the minimum threshold required for a stop sign.

Installing a speed bump on this small section of road will hopefully make this intersection safer for children crossing, walking dogs, and all pedestrians.
